Rules:

The closing date for entries is 30th June 2011.

Cash prizes will be awarded to the three winning entries in each age group, with a cash prize to the school/college of the first prize winner in each age group.

There will be two age groups; Year 6 and under, and Year 7 to Year 13.

Cash prizes will be awarded for the best animations in each age group:

1st Prize £200

2nd Prize £150

3rd Prize £100

A prize of £500 will also be awarded to the School/College of the first prize-winner in each age group.

The running time of the animation should be no less than forty-five seconds and no more than ninety seconds in length. The animation can be recorded using any visual recording device, e.g. camcorder, camera or mobile phone, and be able to be sent via e-mail.
